Scope of Work

- Asbestos surveys
- Licensed asbestos removal & disposal
- Ecology works (Bats & birds)
- Demolition of various industrial (previous military) buildings
- Breaking out slabs and relic foundations
- On site processing of recyclable materials
- Working within a live site alongside other main contractors and other stakeholders
- Pedestrian and traffic management



Project Description



The former Prince Philips Barracks (previously used by the Royal Electrical & Mechanical Engineers) at Bordon is part of a 200 hectare redevelopment scheme by the Whitehill Bordon Regeneration Company. WBRC is a joint development by Taylor Wimpey UK and Dorchester Living. The 20 year contract will completely transform the area creating new high quality living space.

The project called for the phased demolition of the former military base with an number of large scale buildings including a shooting range and extensive underground structures. Building 53, a maintenance and storage facility, had a 7 acres footprint and generated in excess of 750 tonnes of asbestos from the fabric of building alone.

The 12 month programme will release the site for the development of

- 2,400 new sustainable homes
- A new high quality retail/commercial area
- A new leisure centre, school and sports facility
- With employment potential for 3000 jobs
